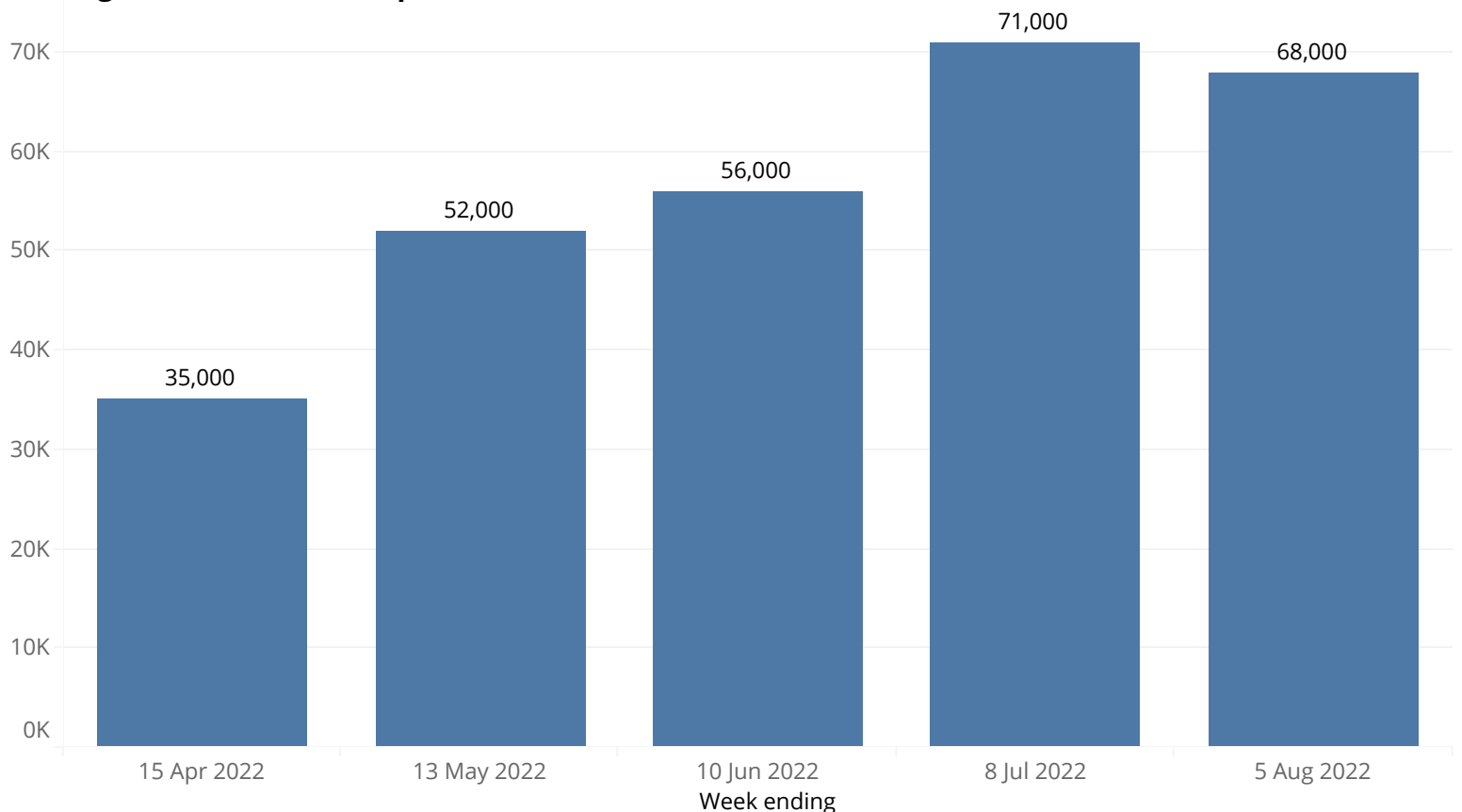
Personal Current Accounts (PCAs) Opened - Year-to-date

PCA YTD Total	365,000
PCA Weekly Average YTD	11,800

BPFI members opened some 365,000 personal current accounts (PCAs) in 2022 up to 5 August. On average, about 11,800 PCAs were opened each week in the year to date.

Account opening activity slowed in July with about 68,000 PCAs were opened in the four weeks ending 5 August, down from 71,000 in the previous four weeks but almost double the total in the four weeks ending 15 April.
