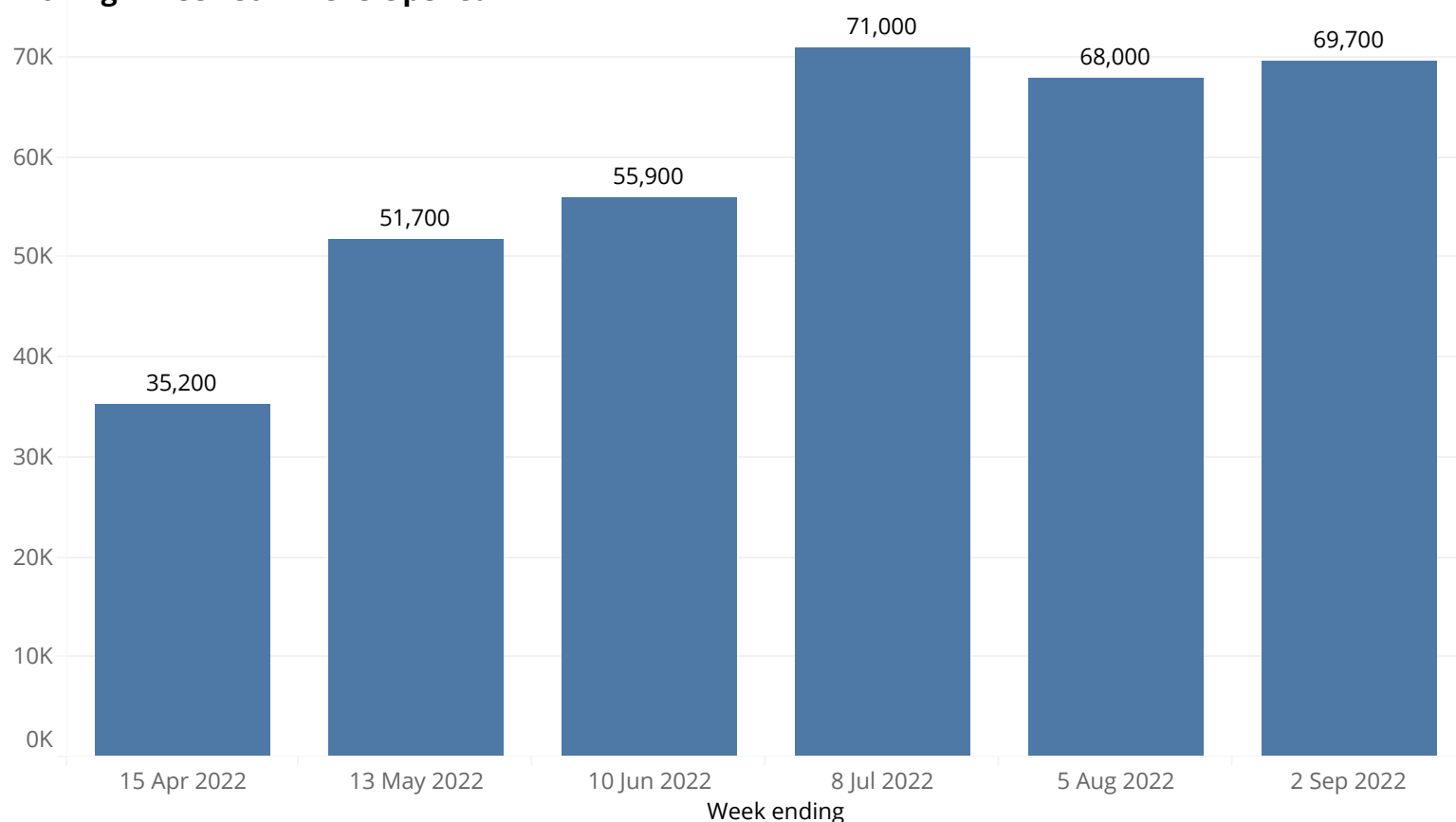
Personal Current Accounts (PCAs) Opened - Year-to-date

PCA YTD Total	434,000
PCA Weekly Average YTD	12,400

BPFI members opened some 434,000 personal current accounts (PCAs) in 2022 up to 2 September. On average, about 12,400 PCAs were opened each week in the year to date.

Account opening activity increased again in August with almost 70,000 PCAs opened in the four weeks ending 2 September, up from 68,000 in the previous four weeks and the second highest level since the data series began.
